Biographical Information:

Dr. Thomas Dayspring was on the Board of Trustees for the Passaic County Historical Society from 1983-1992. He held three different positions during his tenure on the board; Dayspring was Secretary (1984-1988), Vice President (1988-1989) and President (1989-1992). He is a doctor focusing in Postmenopausal Lipidology. Dayspring is still practicing medicine and is an attending physician at St. Joseph's Hospital in Paterson and Wayne, NJ.

Scope Note and Content:

The Dayspring Ephemera collection is part of a much larger collection donated by Dr. Thomas Dayspring. This collection overall houses over forty books and one hundred objects as well as pamphlets and other documents. The entire collection including the ephemera is primarily focused on Paterson in some way or another. The ephemera collection houses tickets to local events held in Paterson, Advertisements for Paterson area stores and businesses as well as memorabilia including maps, anniversary programs and pamphlets regarding several different topics.
