**Scope and Content:**

This collection consists of issues of *Silk*, a trade publication that reported on the silk industry. The contents of these publications include articles about the latest in silk manufacturing technology, job postings, advertisements and trade expositions. The journals contained articles about influential people in the silk industry including articles about the industry in Paterson, Dexter & Lambert Co., Puritan Silk Co., and Catholina Lambert.

**Series:**

This collection is not a complete run of this periodical, but rather a few random issues from the years 1924-1932. The collection is organized chronologically.
